ITINERARY

Picked up from hotel.

Your exploration today is started from the narrow alleys crowded with foodies and vendors in this city's Muslim quarter. Stroll in these alleys will lead you to the Great Mosque, one of China's oldest mosque which was founded in 742AD. It is built in a traditional Chinese courtyard style. Till today, the Great Mosque is still being used as a place of worship for the Muslim people who live here. Enjoy its peace and the sense of history in this unique place.

Followed by the visit of the Great Mosque, you'll climb to the top of the ancient City Wall for an exciting and once-in-a life cycling tour atop it. Used as the fortification of ancient Xian, and now boasts the oldest and best preserved city walls in China. It was built in Ming Dynasty in

1370. Encircling a much smaller city of 14 square kilometers (5.4 sq mi). The wall measures 13.7 kilometers (8.5 mi) in circumference, 12 meters (39 ft) in height, and 15–18 meters (49–59 ft) in thickness at the base. On 28 March 2008, China proposed the Xi'an Fortification be included on UNESCO's World Heritage List, where it is categorized as a tentative listing.

After the tour, drive back to hotel.
