Pick up from hotel.

We'll come to the Small Wild Goose Pagoda, which was built in 707-709 in the Tang Dynasty. It was located within the Buddhist monastery Jian Fu Si, a favored monastery by the royal family, and also the holy place where many of the Buddhist scriptures were translated into Chinese by Monk Yi Jing. If you come in the morning, you'll not only see the small wild goose pagoda, the Xian History Museum with a fantastic collection of the historical relics discovered in China's No. One ancient capital, you'll also see locals dancing, singing, practicing Taijichi in this picturesque garden. What a great harmony of history, nature and human!

Followed by the Small wild Goose Pagoda is *the Great Mosque* and the Muslim quarter. Wandering through the narrow alleys crowded with foodies and vendors, you'll see the Great Mosque, one of China's oldest mosque and founded in 742AD. It is built in traditional Chinese courtyard style and still being used as a place of worship for the Muslims living around. Enjoy it's peace and the sense of history in this unique place.
