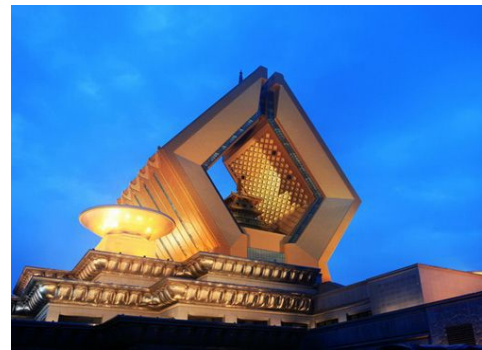

Picked up from hotel.

Drive west bounded for 2 hours to the Famen Temple, which is 120 kilometers west of Xi'an City. In 1987, an underground palace was discovered and four pieces of relics claimed to be directly related to Buddha were found. One of them was declared by experts to be the finger bone of the Sakyamuni Buddha, the founder of the Buddhism. Thereafter, Famen Temple became a the holy place for Buddhist pilgrimage.

Lunch: Local Restaurant

After lunch, drive to visit the Tang Dynasty Qianling Mausoleum, which is 85 km (53 mi) northwest from Xi'an. It is composed of the joint tomb of Emperor Gaozong of Tang Dynasty (r. 649–83), and his wife, China's only female emperor Wu Ze Tian (r. 690–705), as well as 17 smaller attendant tomb. The mausoleum is renowned for its many Tang Dynasty stone statues located above ground and the mural paintings adorning the subterranean walls of the tombs.

After the tour, drive for one hour back to hotel.
